

THE ABCs OF CHOOSING A SIDING COMPANY

Ask

- 1. What is the full name and address of the company? How many years have they been in business?
- 2. Does the company carry insurance? Ask to see certificates and confirm with the issuing company.
- 3. Is the company licensed/credentialed?
- 4. What is the company's workmanship warranty?
- 5. Will the work conform to the manufacturer's warranty and installation instructions?
- 6. Will the company provide referrals or references from previous jobs?
- 7. What is the company's track record for solving customer complaints?
- 8. Would there be any special permits required? Would they obtain them?
- 9. Will the company clean up the premises daily?
- 10. How long will the project take from the start to final clean-up?

Be Certain

- 1. That they check the condition of your exterior walls, insulation, and existing cladding good siding contractors will thoroughly inspect these aspects of your home in order to get an accurate idea of the work that will be required. You may request that they take photos of hard to see areas that they are inspecting in order to show you the condition of the existing structure they are quoting you on.
- 2. Get it in Writing your home belongs to you and you should be in control. Make sure that you are satisfied with the result. The terms of payment should be discussed prior to the job and are adhered to by both parties. It is inadvisable to pay for an entire job upfront. Ensure that you get any manufacturer warranties and contractor guarantees in writing.
- 3. Communication did they return your calls? Did they send the documentation that you asked for? Did they follow through? If you answered, "no", to these questions, then make sure you communicate your concerns to the company representative. If they still can't make good, walk away. If you aren't getting what you need on the front end when they are trying to get your business, it may be indicative of the quality they will deliver.

Choose

- 1. A local contractor make sure that the company that you choose is local. This means that they are not just operating locally now, but have an established business and reputation in the community. If you have a problem within the warranty period, you will want to deal with a company that is still operating. The contractor's warranty is only as good as the longevity and reputation of their company.
- 2. **Workmanship** when choosing a siding contractor, the sales person should show confidence and enthusiasm in their work and be knowledgeable about siding. A good contractor will supply appropriate product literature and samples. They will welcome your questions about siding in general, and their company specifically.
- 3. Value over Price feel free to let the contractor know that you are shopping around but never choose a company based only on price. Cheap bids drive down the market and anyone with overhead and proper insurance has to establish pricing to cover such costs. Customers that are sold on price as their sole criteria often end up spending more money to fix problems and many of these problems would have been covered under a workmanship guarantee by a reputable, established siding company.

Box Mitre

Miters, or corner pieces, are the gutter fittings that connect two gutters at a corner.

Trough

A shallow trough fixed beneath the edge of a roof for carrying off rainwater.

J-Trim

A piece of trim that mounts to the structure at the wall and holds the soffit panel in place.

Elbow

Used when the downspout changes angles and directions.

Downpipe

A pipe to carry rainwater from a roof to a drain or to ground level.

Pipe Strap

A device used to attach a section of gutter to a building's structural framing.

7 Soffit

A horizontal surface under a roof eave that is typically vented allowing for better air circulation.

End Cap

Used to cap off the end of a Trough.

Fascia

A type of horizontal molding applied at rafter ends and the perimeter rake edges of the roof line.

Outlet

A one-piece outlet tube for joining the flat bottom wall of a metal gutter with a vertical downspout is formed from an initially flat blank.

Bracket

Used to fasten the trough to the fascia
